

BVMS Viewer 12.1

The BVMS Viewer allows to live-monitor and replay recorded video from Bosch network attached cameras and recorders. The BVMS Viewer supports the current Bosch video product portfolio as well as legacy Bosch video systems. The software package consists of an Operator Client and a Configuration Client.

The BVMS Viewer is a variant of the BVMS. The free of charge base package includes 16 live only or local storage cameras, 5 Bosch recording solutions and 16 live and playback sites. The system can be expanded with expansion licenses up to 500 cameras and 9999 sites. If enhanced video management functionality is required, the system can easily be upgraded to a BVMS Professional system.

Regulatory information

General Data Protection Regulation

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is enforced on the 25th of May 2018. As a regulation it will be directly applicable to all EU member states without the need for national implementing legislation. As information captured, processed and stored by video surveillance systems is classified as "sensitive" the GDPR will cause significant impact on the video surveillance installations throughout Europe.

BVMS includes the required functionality to ensure an organization can be GDPR compliant.
