1.0 Issue

The Security Escort SE2 Series Transmitters (SE2S-SN, SE2U-SN, SE2U-SN-304, SE2S-SN-304) can be affected by outside radio-frequency (RF) transmitter interference. The SE transmitter sends a false lanyard pull alarm to a monitoring station at the monitoring PC, to an optional integrated paging system, or an optional audible alarm sounds.

2.0 Resolution

SE transmitters produced after August, 15 2004 were modified to be less sensitive to RF transmissions.
